Registration

For the 2022-23 season we had 73 skiers registered as follows:

Lessons

- We returned to a more regular schedule post COVID. All groups except Bunnies
 practiced on Thursday evenings and hot chocolate made a return. Track Attacks
 practiced on Tuesday as well. Junior Racers had Tuesday and Saturday practices when
 not attending races. Bunnies were held Saturday morning.
- Junior racers also has a summer training program to maintain their fitness and work on skills for the upcoming race season. Activities included roller skiing, running and various cross training activities.
- In late October Roddy Ward travelled to Camrose to conduct a clinic for our Junior Racers. Roddy provided instruction on various skills, technique and mental preparation for races.
